

Scholarship Program

The purpose of the United Producers scholarship program is to help and encourage deserving students to pursue careers in agriculture or agriculture-related fields of study.

UPI is offering up to 18 - \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school students pursuing agricultural careers. One scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior in each of UPI's 16 districts and up to two at-large scholarships are available.

Requirements

- Applicants must be a Preferred Member of UPI or a child or grandchild of a Preferred Member. Preferred Members pay an annual membership fee and market at least one head of livestock at UPI. Preferred membership will be based on UPI's 2017 records.
- Applicants must be a 2018 graduating high school senior enrolled in a college or technical school, studying an agriculture-related field.
- Applicants must submit a completed application and essay.

Children and grandchildren of full-time UPI employees or the Board of Directors are not eligible for this award.

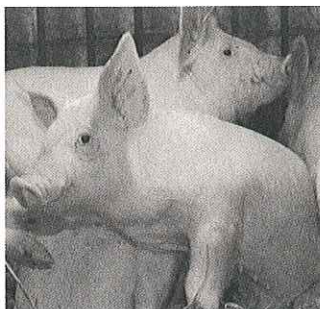
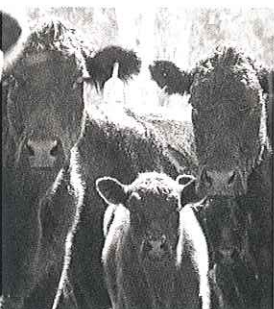
