The ASVAB is a vocational aptitude battery, a multiple-choice test that helps you identify which jobs are best for you.

WHO SHOULD TAKE ASVAB?

The ASVAB is ideal for those whose post-secondary plans include: work, apprenticeships, trade school, 2-year colleges, or the military

WHY TAKE ASVAB ON OCTOBER 24?

A score of at least 31 on the ASVAB can help you qualify for graduation if you are not successful in passing either part of the ISTEP. It can also help you determine pathways for your future.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT DOES THE ASVAB MEASURE? science, math, language arts, and technology; helps assess which jobs you are best suited to perform

HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR THE ASVAB? get a good night's rest, arrive on time

WHO GIVES THE ASVAB, AND WHERE CAN I TAKE IT? @ MCHS in October

WHAT CAN I EXPECT ON THE DAY OF THE TEST? ten short, timed tests in 3 hours

WHAT KIND OF QUESTIONS WILL I BE ASKED ON THE ASVAB? science, math reading, writing, and technologies.

WHAT SCORE DO I NEED TO PASS THE ASVAB? WHAT DO MY SCORES MEAN, AND HOW ARE THEY USED? A score of at least 31 can help you qualify for graduation if you are not successful in passing either part of the ISTEP. You will receive a score report in January.
