

KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS - GRAND DOMAIN OF INDIANA
PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Must be a senior in any high school or home school and a resident of **Indiana**.
- 2) Must have a grade point average of **B (3.0)** or above when in high school.
(copy of transcripts required and **MUST** accompany application). Transcript **MUST** include grade point average and, if available, rank in class. If NOT grading on the 4.0 scale, a copy of the grading scale used **MUST** be included with the application. Failure to do so may disqualify the application! Transcript may be the original or a duplicate copy.
- 3) Applicant **MUST** submit SAT or ACT test results if not on transcript.
- 4) Applicant must be registered in accredited college or university with proof of registration prior to disbursement of funds if you are a WINNER.
- 5) The application must be postmarked on or before January 25, 2019 to be eligible! NONE will be accepted after this date! No need for over night mailings, certified, etc. as long as they are POSTMARKED by the deadline! NO EXCEPTIONS FOR ANY REASON!
- 6) Applicant must submit the attached application. Application may be computer scanned or computer created in a word document to increase size of answer areas. **Question sequence must remain the same!** HAND WRITTEN ANSWERS ON ANY PART OF THE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT be accepted and will be immediately discarded!
- 7) Applicant **MUST** include a short typed essay (600 words or less) about your GOALS AFTER GRADUATING from college. (Attach separate sheet)
- 8) Applicant **MUST** include a short typed essay (600 words or less) regarding your need of financial help. (Attach separate sheet)
- 9) The selection committee annually discards 30% of the applications received for **NOT** following the rules! Don't become a statistic! Good Luck!

AWARD:

- 1) An award of \$1,000 for college expenses, such as books, room & board, tuition, etc will be distributed directly to the college or university office by the Grand Secretary of the Grand Lodge of Indiana in the name of the student. Disbursements **WILL NOT** be made directly to the student - **NO EXCEPTIONS!** If the student withdraws from school before said funds are used, they shall be returned to the Grand Lodge Knights of Pythias of Indiana.
- 2) All winners will be notified by the chairman by telephone by May 1, 2019. Please **DO NOT** call the chairman for results. If you desire a copy of the winners it will posted on www.knightsofpythiasofnewcastle.com following the judging process.
- 3) All awardees will be required to submit Social Security numbers, student ID numbers and final school selection prior to check disbursement.

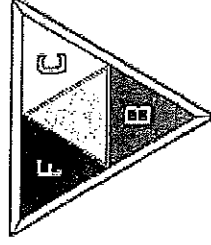

The Knights of Pythias Poster Contest entitled "GO GREEN, SAVE THE WORLD" is open to any student enrolled as a Freshman (Grade 9), Sophomore (Grade 10), Junior (Grade 11), Or Senior (Grade 12) in any Junior or Senior High or Parochial School, or equivalent level Home-schooled students.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Poster may be on any color cardboard, 14 inches by 22 inches (35.6 cm X 55.9cm) uniformly. **DO NOT DEVIATE**
2. Any two dimensional medium may be used. (Computer graphics, photography, stenciling, drawing, painting, etc.)
3. All the art must be ORIGINAL. No copyrighted material may be used in the development of or in the actual entry.
4. On the front of the poster near the bottom, in letters not over 1/4 inch high must Appear the following:

**"SPONSORED BY THE
FRATERNAL ORDER
KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS"**

5. Each contestant must legibly print name, grade, school, home address, phone number and email address if applicable, on the back of the poster

6. The local lodge will be in charge of the local contest in its jurisdiction. (see list of Districts on back) The local lodge will determine the local winner, and must receive all entries by April 1st.

7. All posters become the property of the Knights of Pythias and will not be returned.
