- Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria; academic achievements, school and community involvement, work history and a written essay related to financial literacy.

- Applicants receiving other scholarships are still eligible to win a Loretta M. Burd Scholarship award.
- Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree or certification at an accredited college, university or technical school during the 2019 academic year.
- Students must be enrolled in a part or full-time course of study for the Fall 2019 semester or be enrolled prior to summer (June 2019) disbursement.

- Completed applications and essays must be submitted electronically through the [Centra website](#) before midnight on February 28, 2019.
- High School Scholarship applicants must be a graduating High School Senior.
