

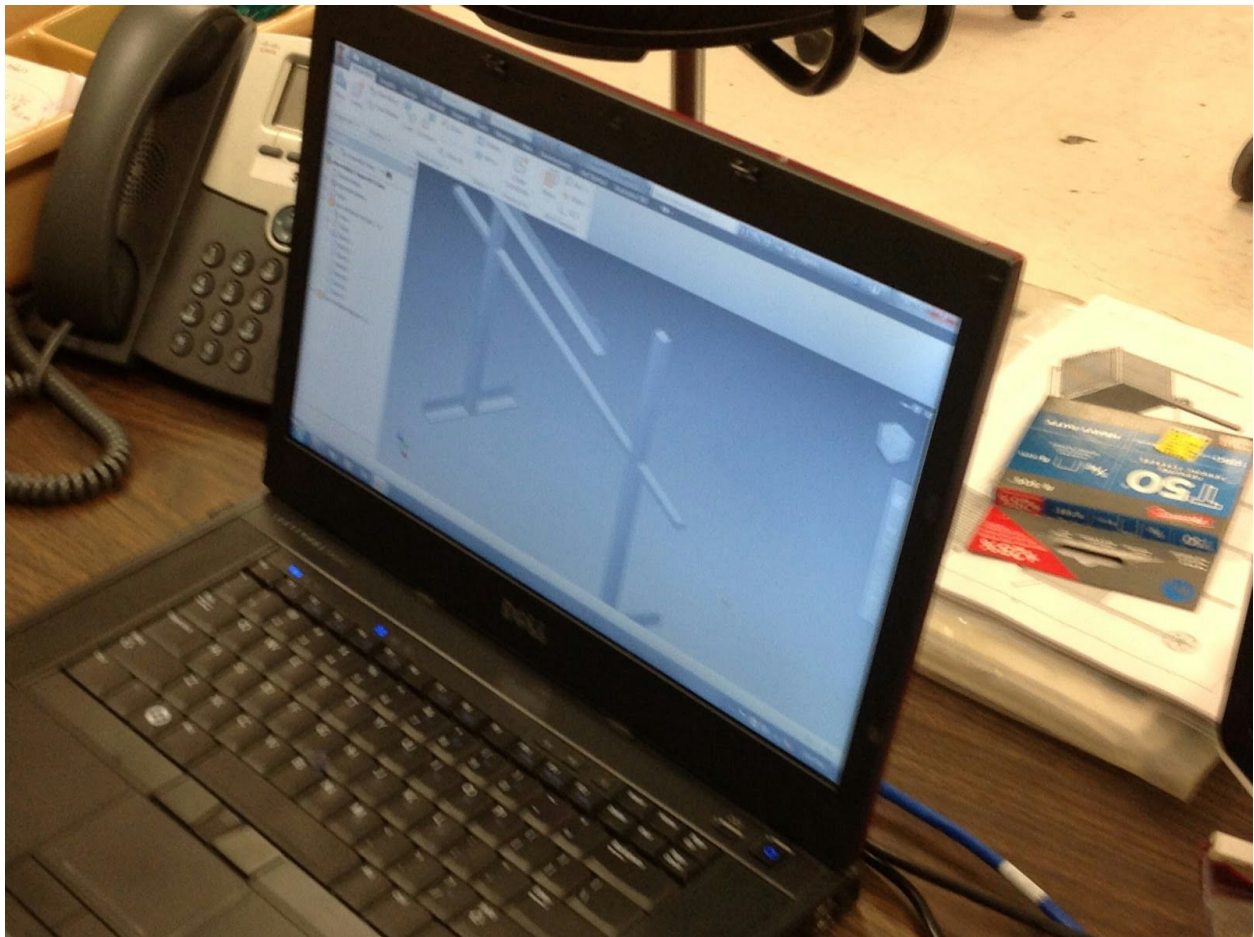
Cub Manufacturing News January 6, 2016

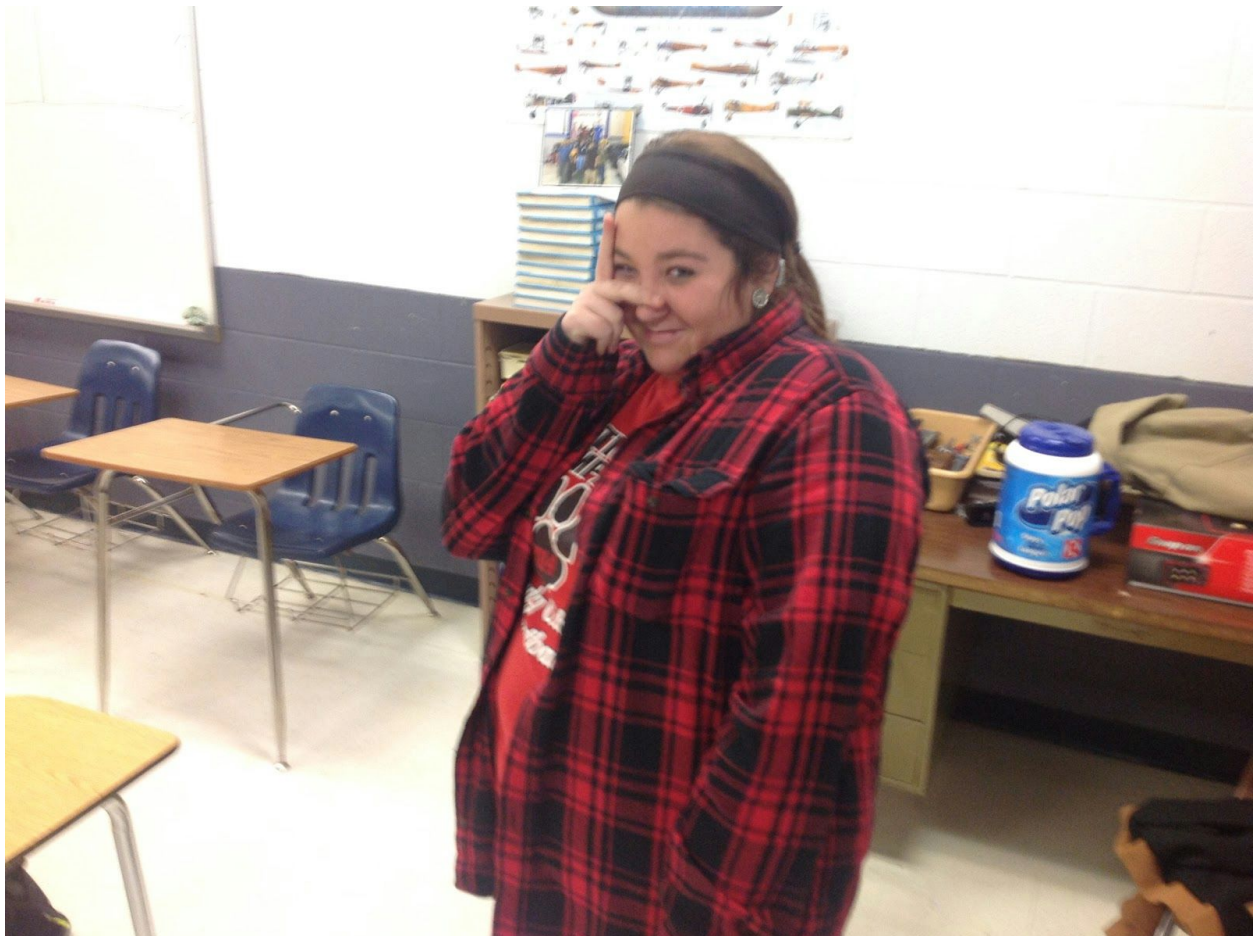
