New Equipment:

We have recently purchased a universal bender. This piece of equipment will help us bend any type of tubing to a specific degree. This is a great addition to the shop floor and enables us bend tubing in order to make all different kinds of tables, as well as, some wall mounted designs.

On other equipment items, Mr. Lamb has been teaching us to program the PlasmaCam system which we can use to create designs for new products. We are learning how important internal maintenance and upkeep is and Mr. Lamb has shown us how replace wire and parts in the Mig Welders.

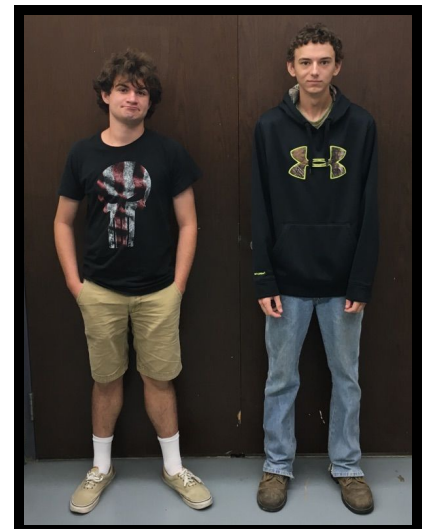
